# **Course Details**

## **Course Check-In**

Located on the 1<sup>st</sup> floor in the main lobby

- Course registration will need to be completed and paid for in full via the website prior to the morning of the course
- On the 1st day you will sign in and fill out a Specimen/Photo Agreement Form
