2,	Under the "Saint Louis University Courses" menu, select "Add a Course".				
3	Select a training course (IRB mandated training is first option). If you are not selecting IRB mandated training, skip steps 4 & 5.				
4	Select "NO" (you haven't taken the basic course) unless you are sure a previous basic HSR course has been accepted by the SLU IRB Office for your account. The refresher course will not satisfy the training requirement on its own.				
5	Select the version of the course you want (BIO/BSS/External Collaborator). Note that the External Collaborator course is not for SLU faculty, staff or students or for anyone who is routinely conducting research.				
6	Your course is located under the "Saint Louis University Courses" menu. NOTE: You must add the IRB required training refresher. However, other refresher courses (GCP, COI refresher) appear automatically on your SLU Courses menu when they are due.
